Intent - Discernment

The Collect.

O Lord, grant we may unfold within us such discernment that we may avoid hurtful things to the Soul, and seek only those things that will advance the universe, we ask this through the promise of Jesus our Christed Master. Amen.

The Epistle for the 11th Sunday after Trinity is from the writings of the Archangel Uriel.

O People of earth; you speak of the things of heaven, yet you understand not the things of earth. Indeed heaven is all around you. You have but to look up from your daily misgivings and your waywardness, and your lusts and your greed, to realize that heaven is all around you in ever expanding grandeur. The hungry hearts of the world are crying out for truth, for they have been starved on everything else. They have been given strict discipline, many religions, and materialistic science, but the human heart has not responded to these. In that they have learned a great lesson, for now they know that only the emanations of Deity will satisfy their hunger, and they seek once again the sacred manna from heaven. I say verily the manna comes and it shall be seen by all of humanity who avail themselves of it.

The Gospel for the 11th Sunday after Trinity is from the Gospel of Truth.

Now when the light appears, we come to recognise that the fear that took hold of us was nothing. Thus we were in ignorance concerning the Father, him who they saw not. When this ignorance that inspired fear and confusion left them uncertain, hesitant, and torn to shreds, there were many vain illusions; and the empty and absurd fictions tormented them, just like sleepers that are prey to nightmares. But when they wake up, all of those dreams are gone. Thus they cast their ignorance away; just like in the dreams and nightmares, the light has shown the way of discernment.
