The 15th Sunday after Trinity

Intent - Love of All.

Candles Many.

The Collect.

O God of greatness and truth, teach us to expand our love within us, that we become worthy disciples to show love to the world in your name, guide us in this quest so we may follow the example of your Christed Avatar. Amen.

The Epistle for the 15th Sunday after Trinity is from the Gnostic Doctors via Leadbeater.

God is love, but love itself cannot be perfect unless it has those upon whom it can be lavished and by whom it can be returned.
