The Following Collect, Epistle & Gospel will be read during the Eucharist today in the personal Chapel of the Presiding Archbishop of the Australian Church of Antioch, The Most Reverend Frank Bugge.

The 21st Sunday after Trinity

Intent - Perseverance.

The Collect.

Lord of all power and might, may our hearts be so filled with gratitude to you that we may continually increase in true religion, and from your Omnipotence may we draw strength to persevere; through the Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Epistle for the 21st Sunday after Trinity is from the writings of Franz Bardon the author.

When persevering on the right path a person will soon confess to having a universal religion. It matters not which religion. The person will keep the good points of any religion and ignore the bad points, knowing that the bad points are not always the truth. The pursuant will delve deeper into God's workshop, and such is the purpose of our persistence. Each truth found is relative to the comprehension of the seeker, and depends upon the maturity of the same. The Adept will not interfere with anyone who seeks, but will try to guide them without criticism. Perseverance by a person will lead them to happiness and contentment if pursued enough. God has supplied many Adepts and teachers to guide humanity through the turmoil, and none can ever have the fear they will be overlooked. The secret to learning is continually seeking and asking questions. Sooner or later if your seeking is genuine and real, a teacher will be made known to you. Perseverance is the ticket to entry into the knowledge of God's world.

The Gospel for the 21st Sunday after Trinity is from the teachings of the Cromlech Temple.

If you decide to overcome any psychic things that are not to your liking, then face the east and trace a cross in the air, and call upon the Master for protection. Know that the primary ritual force used here is from yourself, and you have used an astral fence for protection. Expect not to have immediate results that last for eternity, for some astral forces of evil are strong. As yet you are weak on this level, but as you learn perseverance, you soon learn to repair the astral fences as the evil breaks them down. Eventually your perseverance will get you to where your fences are strong. Each attempt at doing good work increases the strength of your fence to the point where the power of evil is depleted trying to break it down.
