The Collect

O God, who has watched over us since the ancient of days, allow us to acquire the wisdom of the ages which you have within your being, that we may learn and in turn teach this wisdom to others deserving of its merits, this we ask in the name of the messenger, the Christed Lord. Amen.

The Epistle for the 22nd Sunday after Trinity is from the recorded words of Osiris via his prophets.

God's will for each person is an unfailing process, and his will is that every one be an expression of his love, thus the statement --- be ye therefore perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect.
